Since June 2019, I am a doctoral student at the chair of Environmental Governance and a researcher in the project "KASCOP" founded by the German Ministry of Education and Research. My doctoral project focuses on structural changes in markets, investigating the dynamic interactions between elements that "perform" a market - actors as well as material elements. In doing so, a particular focus is set on the development of so-called market-shaping practices, analyzing market dynamics from a historical and sociological

point of view. Overall, my current research interest concerns the investigation of different governance approaches to bring changes in market structures for more efficient use of natural resources in production processes.
