APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To attend the Erasmus programme at UnitelmaSapienza, **the main steps are as follows:**

Once your Institute has officially nominated you,

you will be contacted by e-mail from UnitelmaSapienza's Erasmus and International Mobility Commission (erasmus@unitelmasapienza.it).

- **STEP 1:** Consult our courses, choose the exams you want to sustain, fill in and submit your [Learning Agreement for Studies \(or Traineeship\)](#), to the Erasmus and International Mobility Commission (erasmus@unitelmasapienza.it).

The Learning Agreement shall include all the learning outcomes that the Incoming Student is expected to acquire during the Erasmus mobility.



ATTENTION

THE Learning Agreements MUST BE COMPILED through the EWP SYSTEM – OLA PLATFORM <https://learning-agreement.eu/>

- **STEP 2:** The Learning Agreement sets out the programme of studies (or traineeship) to be followed at UnitelmaSapienza and must be approved by the Student, the sending Institution/University and UnitelmaSapienza **before the start of the Erasmus mobility**.

Note: Once in Rome, Incoming Students have one month from the enrolment at UnitelmaSapienza to submit a request for changing their Learning Agreements, which must be also agreed upon by the sending Institutions.

You do not need to submit any other form of Application.



Accommodation

UnitelmaSapienza does not provide or cover the cost of accommodation in Rome. Thus, before moving from their Countries, Incoming Students shall start looking for an accommodation at their earliest convenience.

Language Skills

Erasmus Incoming Students should have either a **B1 level in Italian language or a B2 level in English language**. If not, they are required to assess their knowledge and/or attend the language courses provided by [OLS \(Online Linguistic Support\)](#).

When you arrive

Welcome Day

Incoming Students must send an e-mail to erasmus@unitelmasapienza.it to make an appointment to be welcomed by UnitelmaSapienza's **Student Service Office**.

Incoming Students have to provide their Identification Documents and all the other required documents supplied by the sending Universities, and refer to the International Relations Office for all the administrative duties related to their mobility at UnitelmaSapienza.

How To

Incoming Students are informed by the **Student Service Area** on the enrolment procedure at the courses that they have to attend during the Erasmus mobility, how to access to and use the UnitelmaSapienza e-learning platform, how to check schedules, and more!

Certificate of Arrival

Upon request, a **Certificate of Arrival** is supplied to Incoming Students, while the Transcript of Records is provided at the end of their Erasmus mobility.
