Leverage points for sustainability transformation in the Finnish (circular) plastic packing system

Dalia D'amato - Dalia D'Amato is a Senior Researcher at the Finnish Environment Institute (SYKE). She is also affiliated as an Adjunct Professor at the University of Helsinki (Department of Forest Sciences, Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry), and as a member of the Helsinki Institute of Sustainability Science (HELSUS). Before gaining her PhD in forest economics and marketing at the University of Helsinki (2016), she completed two MSc degrees related to ecology and biodiversity management, respectively at the University of Sussex (UK) and the University of Roma Tre (Italy). Current research interests include solution-oriented sustainability narratives, such as the green, circular, and bioeconomy, and related societal and organisational transformations; business sustainability in the forest sector and other land use-

intensive sectors; biodiversity-underpinned ecosystem services and the governance of socio-ecological systems, including the role of science-policy interfaces. She serves as an editor for the journal Circular Economy and Sustainability (Springer) and the journal Canadian Journal of Forest Research (Canadian Science Publishing).
